Krupanj is small town located in western Serbia, near the Drina river and boarder with Bosnia and Herzegovina, which was badly damaged during the recent floods in	

Serbia. Connections between Krupanj and surrounding larger cities are frequently difficult due to bad roads and hilly terrain. Primary health care centre plays an important role in providing health care to all inhabitants, including children and women, as a most vulnerable ones. Health care service for women and children was flooded, so it needs reconstruction.


